Better still, it was designed by graduates of Victoria Polytechnic in Footscray, part of Victoria University. The graduates, under the leadership of Beata Cranswick, did a "wonderful" job according to 'Chief Bar Officer' Mathew O'Keefe

"We had a really set idea about what the bar needed but they blew that out of the water with something completely original that perfectly encapsulated what the area and philosophy behind the bar are all about". O'Keefe explains.

Pride of our Footscray is looking to celebrate all aspects of Footscray, going all out as a Community Bar. Shane Bridges, one of the driving forces behind the bar, explained what the Community Bar concept was all about.

"Firstly, we're owned by the community, the bar is not owned by one or two people like most of the others, it's owned by over 150 people. Anyone in the community can buy shares in Pride of our Footscray until September 29. Some people have been buying shares because they love the idea whilst others

have bought shares because they just think it's cool to part-own a bar.

"Hopefully they turn up to drink at their own bar," says Bridges. As well as the community ownership structure, O'Keefe says the bar would support local breweries of the inner-West, performers of the inner-West, artists of the inner-West and restaurants of the inner-West.

"We'll be partnering with Footscray's incredible restaurant scene, the Vietnamese and Ethiopian particularly are a constant delight and we're hoping guests will be able to eat their way around Footscray without leaving their bar stool," O'Keefe says. "We also want a diverse array of local and different entertainment, be that educational nights, tasting events, drag queens, live music or can can dancers. This won't be boring."

"We also want to celebrate technology, because geeks are people too", said O'Keefe with his geeky grin.

"We'll therefore be accepting Bitcoin for beer, SegWit notwithstanding."

Finally, what's with the name "Pride of our Footscray"?

"We didn't set out to artificially create the P.O.O.F. acronym," Bridges says.

"That would have been too contentious and potentially exclusionary."

"Rather, we started as Proud of Footscray and when we released that was P.O.F. well adding the extra "O" was too tempting an in-joke. You won't see the acronym much, if at all though, it's an in-joke because we're juvenile".

The bar will instead welcome people of all backgrounds and will certainly have an LGBTIQA+bent.

"Can everyone just please get along?" is the question the bar asks.
